Test of one-sided hypotheses on the expected value of a fuzzy random variable*

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Abstract. In this paper we present a procedure to test one-sided hypotheses about the population expected value of a fuzzy random variable. This procedure is based on a parameterized ranking function making the hypotheses being equivalent to classical ones for the population mean of a real-valued random variable.
